	Conscious Level	RESPONSE																	
A	Alert	Usual level of consciousness. Able to maintain spontaneous eye opening, verbal response																	
V	Voice	Has become drowsy but rousable. Able to respond when spoken to (such as actual speech or grunt).																	
P	Pressure	Has become very drowsy and only responds with gentle shaking																	
U	Unresponsive	Does not show any response to being spoken to or gentle shaking																	
	Fit	Record (F) and time																	
	Vomited	Record (V) and time																	

C	Confusion Level	RESPONSE																	
	No Change	No change in usual level of confusion or behaviour																	
	Acute Change	Increase level of confusion or change in behaviour																	

M	Mobility Levels	RESPONSE																	
	Usual mobility	Usual level of mobility																	
	Usual weakness	Usual weakness or power in arms or legs																	
	Weakness in arms	Record left (L) or right (R)																	
	Weakness in legs	Record left (L) or right (R)																	

P	Pupils	RESPONSE																	
	Equal Size	Both pupils are equal in size																	
	React to light	Both pupils react equally by constricting to light (record +)																	
	Unequal size	One pupil is larger than the other. Record (L) or (R)																	
	Unequal reaction	Pupils do not react to light. Record (L) or (R) (record -)
