

Pan-London Suspected Haematological Cancer Two-Week Wait Process

Highly abnormal FULL BLOOD COUNT / BLOOD FILM	Monoclonal paraprotein band on serum electrophoresis > 10 g/L	Unexplained splenomegaly	abnormal FBC but no highly abnormal criteria or red flag symptoms.
Abnormal FBC with unexplained red flag symptoms	Raised serum free light chains with abnormal ratio >5 or <0.1	Persistent lymphadenopathy *≥ 6 weeks; <i>lymph nodes</i> ≥ 2cm or increasing in size	*abnormal paraprotein but not meeting criteria for Myeloma
	Urine Bence-Jones proteins suggestive of myeloma	Lymphadenopathy with fever, night sweats, shortness of breath, pruritus or weight loss	Clinical Concerns that do not meet NICE/pan-London referral criteria
	Paraprotein* (any level) plus one or more : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unexplained abnormal renal • bone profile or FBC • red flag symptoms 	Enlarged lymph nodes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Neck • Groin • Axilla • Neck only
